Jackie Lund

For the past 45 years, Jackie Lund has contributed to the physical education profession as a teacher in the K-12 schools and as a teacher educator. As a teacher educator, she has served on several NAKHE committees as well as secretary for the organization and Executive Secretary Treasurer. Jackie has presented at numerous NAKHE conferences and presented the forty-fourth 2010 Amy Morris Homans lecture. She served on the Future Directions Committee 2011-2014 and chaired the committee in 2012-2013. In 2009 she was awarded the NAKPEHE Distinguished Service Award and in 2014 was the NAKHE Distinguished Scholar. Elsewhere in higher education, Jackie has been active in her state professional organizations, serving as president of the Colorado AHPERD in 1985-86. In 2006-07 she was president of the National Association for Sport and Physical Education, served as the NASPE representative to the Board of Governors, and is currently president-elect of SHAPE America. Her passion is to improve the quality of physical education teaching which led to being a part of the committee to develop the first national standards for physical education in 1995. She also chaired the committee that developed the standards for Georgia physical education in 2008. Jackie is a Fellow in the North American Society and the SHAPE America Research Consortium. In 2013 she was the Southern District Scholar and in that same year was inducted into the NASPE Hall of Fame for Physical Education. Jackie has written several books with emphasis on her work with assessment and curriculum development.
