The 2023 Annual Conference will be held January 4-7, 2023, at the Intercontinental Hotel in New Orleans, Louisiana. Call for Research Participation!

This is an invitation for NAKHE members to participate in a research project that Dr. Laura Alfrey (Monash University), Dr. David Aldous (Cardiff Metropolitan University), and Dr. Dylan Scanlon (Dublin City

University) are leading.

The project is titled "Policy and Policy Work in Health and Physical Education" and the ethical approval number from the Monash University Human Research Ethics Board is: 32209.

The purpose of this research is to generate insight into the way Health and Physical Education teacher educators conceptualise policy and policy work. To gather such data, we have constructed a survey that takes approximately 15-20 minutes to complete.
